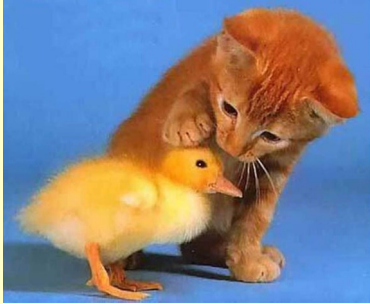

- We will be looking at creating our own salt dough animals

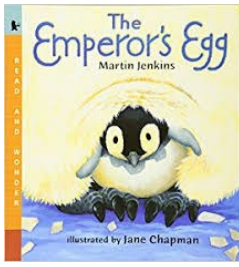
In Music we will be finding out about:

In English the children will be given the opportunity to study The Emperor's Egg. This is a fantastic book and includes great facts about penguins and Antarctica.

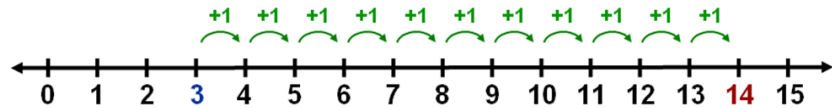

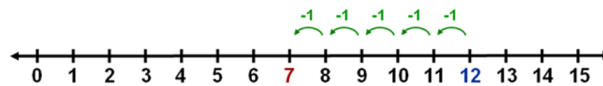
ADDITION

SUBTRACTION

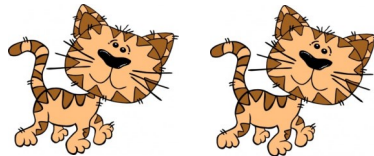
Counting back in ones on a number line

15 roses shared between 3 = 5 roses each
