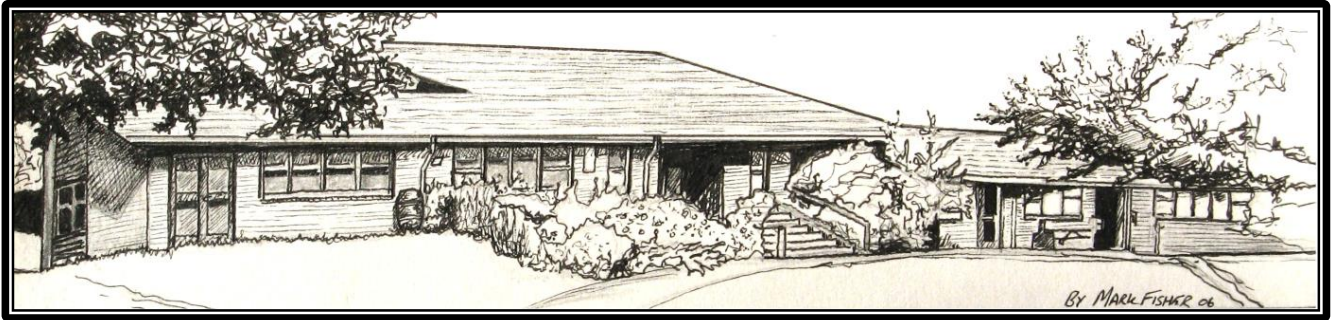


# Sedlescombe Church of England Primary School
