Hear your child read every night, 5 quality minutes, one to one without distractions
Don't ever see it as a chore or another job to be done



Help us develop your child's positive mind set of "I can do it".
Let your child sound talk their words themselves whilst you support and encourage
without telling them

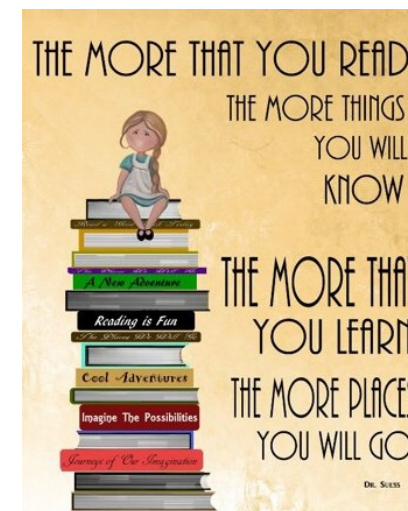
Encourage your child to draw invisible sound buttons with their finger when sound talking words they don't know.

Have discussions about the pictures, this builds confidence as a reader and as a narrator.



Ask questions:

- What has happened and why?
 - What might happen next?
- What clues do you get from the picture?
 - How do you think she feels now?
 - How do you know?
- Has that ever happened to you?



Read for pleasure, have a story before bed. Visit the library and encourage your child to have a life long love for reading.
