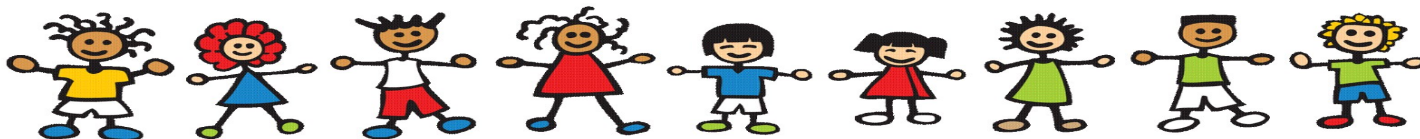
In addition to this there will be the opportunity for children to stay after school for a class disco/party. This will only go ahead if there are enough children that wish to attend (20 children).
