Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Year 1 Trip to the Pantomime

We are very excited to be able to tell you that the Year 1 children will be going to see a pantomime at Christmas this year!

We have booked Robin Hood at the White Rock for Wednesday 15th December. The pantomime is at 10.30 am, and we aim to be back at school by 1.00pm. We will be travelling to and from the theatre by coach. As we will have missed lunch, we kindly ask that you provide your child with a packed lunch on this day and we will eat in class when we get back to school. If your child is entitled to benefits related (not universal) free school meals and you would like us to provide a packed lunch on this day then please indicate this on the reply slip attached and we will ensure that a packed lunch is provided for your child.

We also thought it would be fun if the children came to school in fancy dress – perhaps dressed up as a pantomime character. Please don't get too much effort whatever you have in the dressing-up box will be fine. Please make sure they are warm. If your child would rather not dress up they can wear school uniform as usual.

The cost of the trip is £18.50 per child. This includes the cost of the ticket to the pantomime, an ice cream during the interval and the coach journey. We have set up payment on the School Gateway with an option of splitting the cost into two instalments, as we know this is an expensive time of year. You can either make one payment in October and one in November or make payment in full any time before Monday 22nd November. Please indicate which payment option you are choosing on the reply slip. Although this is a voluntary contribution, if we do not receive enough contribution then the trip may have to be cancelled.

We hope you agree that this will be a really exciting opportunity for the children. Nothing quite beats the school performance of the pantomime!
