

Year 3 Optional Homework Tasks



Create a piece of natural disaster art work using any mediums you wish. You could create a silhouette of a tsunami or a volcano with a splatter paint effect. You could use charcoals and chinks to show a tornado.

Watch videos or read information books to find out about the Richter scale. Write a definition of what it is and draw a labelled diagram.

Design an earthquake-proof house. How could you prevent the building from collapsing during an earthquake?

Imagine you have just survived an earthquake. Write a short story about what happened. Make sure you include factual information such as the earthquake's strength. Use geographical words in your account such as tremor, seismic isolator, aftershock and epicentre.

Design a poster to show a volcano's main features. Make sure you label its important parts. Can you make this poster 3D?

Take part in the chocolate rock cycle lesson to use chocolate to create models of Sedimentary, Metamorphic and Igneous Rocks. Take pictures of your creations and label the key properties of these rocks.
