With parental permission, watch one or more of the following movies to get an idea of certain elements of WW2:

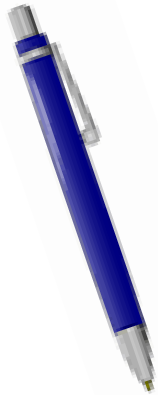
- Goodnight Mr Tom
